As restrictions ease, our Sunday services will eventually be able to return to life in all its fullness! However, to make this happen we need people to get involved in the following ways.

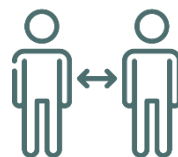
- **Hospitality**- Welcoming at the door and serving refreshments afterwards.

COVID MEASURES AFTER 19th JULY

The pews at the sides of church are further distanced from those in the middle and are there for those who would like to keep a bit more distance- please respect those choosing to sit there.

We aren't going to start refreshments after the service just yet (we're taking it one step at a time) but hope to reintroduce them soon!
